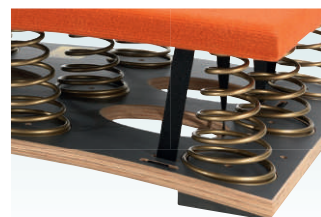




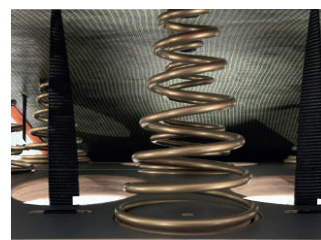

 Surface: Hybrid Carbon fiber sandwich, with 20 mm PP-180, a high density foam and covered with comfortable needle felt for long-lasting use. The lightweight top makes it fast responding with a reduced impact for the gymnasts.
 Lower part: High quality birch plywood, provided with new non-skid floor protectors guarantee the best stability. The large openings make the board easy to carry.
 Height limitation: Different nylon straps guarantee the correct height and maintain the right curve of the board.

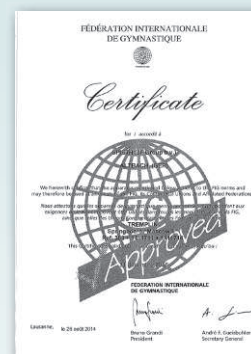


FIG certified competition model.
